

Online Registration for Scouts and Adult Volunteers

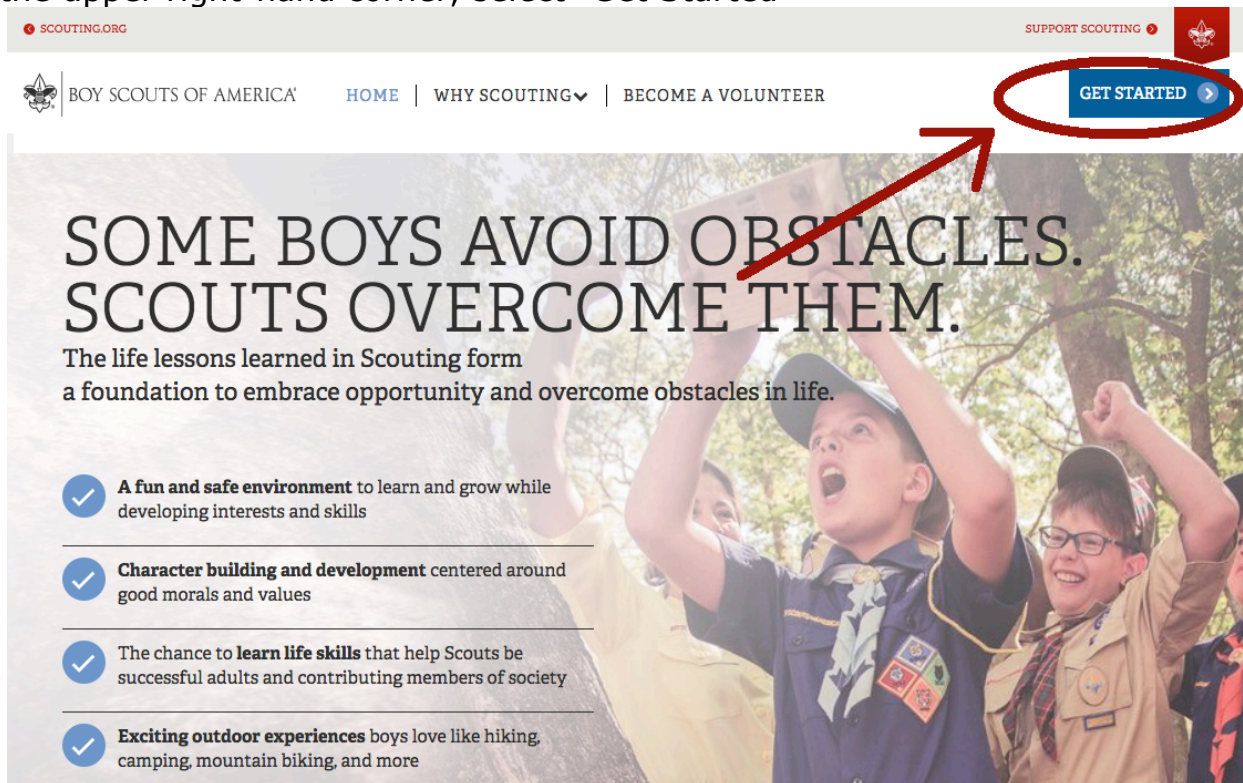
The Boy Scouts of America launched an on-line registration process in the Fall of 2016. This feature is currently only available to select councils across the United States, and the Chief Seattle Council is fortunate enough to be amongst some of the first councils to use this online tool.

Prospective Scouts and Adult Volunteers joining Troop and Crew 100 here in Ballard no longer need to fill out the cumbersome paper or carbon-copy registration form. All one needs to do know is to simply go online, navigate to the BSA's entry portal for registration, and begin the process to join the finest scout unit in Ballard (*and arguably the planet!*).

Registration Steps:

1. Go to <https://beascout.scouting.org>
2. In the upper right-hand corner, select "Get Started"



3. You will be taken to a new page that allows you to pick what type of Scouting experience you wish to join. The choices are Cub Scouts, Boy Scouts, Venturing, and being a Volunteer.
4. To join Troop 100, simply choose "Boy Scouts." Choose "Venturing" if you are a youth 14 years of age or older and wish to join our great Crew 100. Adults looking to support either or both units through volunteering their time and talents must also register by selecting "Volunteering."



5. Next, type in your ZIP Code for Units near you (Troop and Crew 100 is at 98117).

6. Click on "Show Unit" for "Troop 0100 Parents Group of Troop 100." The Parent's Group is currently our chartering organization. This will be changing to our new non-profit shortly.
7. In the detail box that appears over the map, click on "Apply Now" to be taken to the new on-line registration form pre-populated with Troop 100 as the unit you wish to join.
8. Once on the page with the actual membership form, simply follow the on-line instructions and fill out the appropriate information. It's that easy!
